Read: Matthew 22:19-21 God or Caesar? Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. Which commandments or laws did the Pharisees break in this passage?
- 2. What do you believe are things that belong to the world and which things belong to God? Can you separate them?

Prayer Focus God, we've been known to walk into the temple with Cesar's image in our hands, with the world's attractions in our hearts. Forgive us. Justify us within your margins, not the world's. Heal us so we put you first, over all else.

Friday

Read: Matthew 22:22 The trap fails Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. What was so amazing to Jesus's listeners?
- How would you answer the questions in this passage: what do you owe to God, and what do you owe to the world?

Prayer Focus Amazing God, we want to improve on our past. We have fond memories and dark ones but we have mercies that are here and now, new each morning. We commit ourselves to learning from the past, and we ask for your guidance for the journey ahead.
