- 1. What was Simeon's great hope?
- 2. How are you patient with God's time?

Prayer Focus Simeon waited decades for a sign that your promise was fufilled. We don't have to wait for you, Jesus, but we do need patience and eyes to see your work, to live out what you began, with the courage of faith that looks for hope, always.

Thursday

Read: Luke 2:25-29 Simeon's witness Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. What does it mean that salvation was "in the presence of all peoples?"
- 2. How can we share the consolation and the light in our lives this week?

Prayer Focus We still long for the consolation and redemption of our world, Holy One. Teach us again to look to you as Simeon did, with eyes that see you as the answer to our needs.

Friday

Read: Luke 2:36-38 Anna's witness Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. Anna, Simeon, and the shepherds were all "outsiders," yet they were among the first apostles. How is that important to you?
- 2. What signs of hope and redemption do you see around you today? How can you pass them along?

Prayer Focus We treasure the stories and signs you sent to make way for Jesus to enter our world. In Advent, we stand ready to share our own stories of help and hope with others in the coming year.

Tuesday

Read: Luke 2:21-24 The dedication rite Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. Why was circumcision a sacred rite?
- 2. What is the significance of Jesus' dedication? What did it mean to him, his parents, his ministry?

Prayer Focus You came to us as fully human, born into our world, our traditions, our rituals. You participated in our lives, even as you remained divine. Thank you for showing us how to live in community, and make faithful commitments to God's way.
