Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. This word for peace means "wholeness." How might the world look if our goal was wholeness on earth?
- 2. "Let's go see." Is there someone you'd like to invite to come and see with you? Pray for them. Invite them.

## **Thursday**

Read Luke 2:16-19 What the shepherds found Questions for Reflection and Application

## Friday

Read Luke 2:20 The shepherds spread the news Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. This wasn't just a personal revelation for the shepherds alone. How did you first hear the news? Give thanks.
- 2. The shepherds praised the one who brought this wonder to the world. How will you share the news in the coming year?

**Prayer Focus** It's Christmastime at last. We're eager to begin a new story of how you're still coming, Jesus, of how you are still here with us, and how we will live in you, now and always.
