- 1. What was the fulfillment of the scripture that Jesus read and the people heard?
- 2. What might that fulfillment look like in our lives? In our world?

Prayer Focus We have heard, Beloved. You made it possible for us to see that our fears and weakness can end with you. We are healed, inspired, freed, and anointed by you to proclaim and fulfill your mission to our world.
