Friday

Read Luke 3:22 God's blessing on Jesus Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. What was pleasing to God in that moment?
- 2. What can you do to welcome and follow the Holy Spirit in this season?

Prayer Focus God called you Beloved, Jesus. Help us to remember in our hearts that God also calls us "beloved." We commit ourselves today to live as people who really believe in that name and rejoice to share it with others.

Monday

Read Psalm 29 The greatness of God Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. The voice of God is active, powerful, creative. Offer thanks for the gifts that God spoke into being.
- 2. What strength do you need this week?

Prayer Focus We hear your voice in the world you created and within our own hearts. We lift your name first of all, today, God, as we acknowledge that you are the Creator, in charge of all. You are worthy of our praise and our trust.

Tuesday

Read Luke 3:15-16 John's prophecy Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. What were the people expecting? Why?
- 2. Baptizing with the Holy Spirit and with fire—is this comforting to you? How are these different compared to baptism by water?

Prayer Focus Jesus, you were baptized not because you were sinful but because you wanted to be with us, to be both our divine example and part of our lives together. Remind us that when we were baptized, you sealed our adoption into the family of God.
