Read Luke 5:8-10 A sinful man

Questions for Reflection and Application

1. Simon's first response is to fall on his knees and confess. What might be your response to a miracle like this?

2. Jesus tells them not to be afraid. Why? **Prayer Focus** Jesus, you didn't go away when Simon bowed and begged. You could have dismissed him and left but you understood his fears and insecurities. We know we often fear what you might ask of us. Free us from our doubts, so we can hear your call.

Friday

Read Luke 5:11 *They left everything* **Questions for Reflection and Application**

- 1. What did you leave behind when you chose to go with Jesus?
- 2. What does catching people mean to you today?

Prayer Focus Jesus, call us again. Take us on the journey you have mapped out for us, no matter what we might expect. We commit ourselves to follow you on the Great Adventure.

- 1. People were crowding Jesus. Why didn't they go to a synagogue to hear the word of God?
- 2. Why do you think Jesus climbed into one of their empty boats? How might you have reacted if it was your boat?

Prayer Focus You always turn things upside down, Jesus. You showed up outside of the synagogue, right where we didn't expect you. You still come to us, Jesus, right into where we work and live. We pray to be ready to see you wherever we are and whatever we are doing, eager to hear your voice.

Tuesday

Read Luke 5:3-5 Jesus sends Simon out to deep water Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. Why do you think Jesus chose Simon's boat?
- 2. Simon must have been tired and discouraged, yet still agreed to take Jesus out in his boat. What did he expect?

Prayer Focus

Renew our curiosity about you, Jesus. Open our hearts to the wonder of really seeing you, no matter what our situation. Let us take a chance on following you out to deep waters, our eyes on you.
