Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. The Marys were commissioned as the first to share the gospel of the risen Christ. What does their role in the Easter story mean to you?
- 2. Reflect on the angel's message. What is your hope today?

Prayer Focus "He has been raised from the dead." Death was never the last word for you, Beloved, and hope is still your message. Help us to have the courage to embrace that hope as way to live.

Thursday

Read: Matthew 28:8-9 Jesus is alive Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. What fears and joys might they have had as they ran to tell the disciples? What would be your reaction?
- 2. How is Jesus still going ahead of us today?

Prayer Focus We worship you, Immanuel, as followers, who are reminded again at Easter of all you've given us. Help us sing and pray our gratitude that you never have and never will leave us alone.

Friday

Read: Matthew 28:10 Do not be afraid Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. What is new for you this Easter as you reflect on the Lenten journey to the resurrection?
- 2. Spend time in thanks and praise for all that you can do with courage in the risen Christ.

Prayer Focus "Don't be afraid. You will see me. Tell others. Show others." We hear you, risen Christ. We will live so they can see you in us.

Tuesday

Read: Matthew 28:4-6 He is not here Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. What gave the Marys the courage to step into a tomb with an angel?
- 2. What do you imagine the women were thinking when they saw the empty tomb?

Prayer Focus The guards fainted for fear of the angel, and we are sometimes afraid to hear your message, Holy One. Yet we know you did not rise to scare us but to show us hope and courage in you. Thank you.
