Friday

Read: Jeremiah 1:8 God's reassurance Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. What are your fears when you think of stepping out to speak? Whom do you fear most?
- 2. What might be your first step to hear and answer God's call this week?

Prayer Focus God, be our guide and protector today and always. We stand ready to believe that you've created us for a reason and that we can live out your call to be your light in our world, wherever that may lead.

Tuesday

Read: Jeremiah 1:5b Jeremiah's commission Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. Why did God want Jeremiah to speak to the nations, and not just his own people?
- 2. Do you think God needs you, specifically, to be a messenger?

Prayer Focus God of all the prophets, we don't know if you're calling us to speak to all the world, but we do know you're calling to our hearts as your children. It's not always easy to see what you want or to know how to witness for you. Help us to hear your voice speaking in our day-to-day world.
