# **Thursday**

Read: Isaiah 1:18 How things could change Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. Do you ever argue with God?
- 2. What might your life look like if God made you as clean as new snow? What might change?

**Prayer Focus** You are the God speaks to us, the God who longs, passionately, for a relationship with us. The God who doesn't give up on us. Keep calling, Great Redeemer. Keep telling us you believe we can change and do better.

## Friday

Read: *Isaiah 1:19-20 Our choice*Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. What does it mean to you when God says failing to obey his command will lead to our destruction?
- 2. How can we create worship that leads us into living out God's command to be just and compassionate?

**Prayer Focus** Gracious One, may we bring you a sacrifice of our own wants and lives, and a commitment to greater faith. May we engage in worship that daily fills us with the will and courage to serve you, for the healing of our world.

# Monday

Read: Isaiah 1:1;10-12 God's displeasure Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. How do you feel about God's comparison of us with the people of Sodom and Gomorrah? (Genesis 18:1-19:29)
- 2. Reflect on a worship experience that really moved you. What touched your heart?

**Prayer Focus** It's hard for us to hear your anger, God. Even if we come to church, and give to the church, you say you don't want what we bring to worship. Show us where we trample your house. Remind us of why we are there: because of your love and forgiveness.

## **Tuesday**

Read: Isaiah 1:13-15 Empty worship
Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. What would our lives be like if God refused to deal with us? If God refused to listen or answer prayers?
- 2. Reflect on a time when a worship experience left you empty or cold. What was it about that time that didn't fulfill you?

**Prayer Focus** God of all power, you are the speaker for everyone left out of our mercy, generosity, and concern. We acknowledge that we fail to hear them, even as we pray to you. We see how hollow our worship is when we fail to offer the love and justice you so generously give to us.
