## Wednesday

Read Galatians 3:27 How we accept Christ Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. What does your baptism mean to you today? (If you are not baptized, how might it shape your life?)
- 2. How does your life show that you are clothed with Christ?

Prayer Focus New clothes, new life; we put on you, Jesus, when we are baptized into your family. We acknowledge that we're walking around wearing you like our clothes, for all to see. Remind us of your image in us, and help us live in your love, respecting and revering each person.

## **Thursday**

Read Galatians 3:28 All labels fall away Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. How do divisions fade when we are baptized in Christ?
- 2. When do you feel most like you are one in Christ? Prayer Focus Redeemer, many of us have been hurt by labels and divisions we've put on ourselves and others. Erase the lines that allow to come between us. Show us how being yours takes us from separation into community, from isolation into belonging.

## **Friday**

Read Galatians 3:29 How we belong Questions for Reflection and Application

- 1. What is the promise that Paul mentions here?
- 2. How can we live lives that reflect God's promise?

**Prayer Focus** Sustainer, you came to fulfill the law and the prophets and in you we can serve God's promise: that God would bless all the people of the world. We re-commit to being agents of your blessing today and always.
