

WHO IS OUR NEIGHBOR?

A decline in population & church activity

- 4,700 people have moved out of Sonoma County in the past 2 years
- Family households with children declined 11% 2010 to 2019
- School enrollment expected to decline 15% in next 10 years
- Active in a religious congregation; 32.4% in 2012, 28.5% in 2017

An aging population

- More than 25% of the county's population is over 60 years old, up 45,000 people since 2010
- Retirement opportunities (65 & over) 23,342 in 2010, 31,060 in 2019
- Family households with children declined 11% 2010 to 2019

Racial & Ethnic Diversity (Census Bureau categories)

- 2.2% Black/African American
- 4.8% Pacific Islander/American Indian/Other
- 4.9% Asian
- 30.5% Hispanic or Latino
- 57.7% White

High cost of living

- Affordability of housing rent and owning
- Availability of housing drives up cost
- Santa Rosa 11th most wealthy community in the U.S. USA Today article on 24/7 Wall Street study
