

The Fine Print

Commitment:

Triads meet at least weekly for eight to ten weeks of a specified season.

Group members decide when & how to meet.



Length of meeting:

Approximately 45-60 min.



Format:

Each person lifts up one special praise.

Each person shares one
personal struggle. After sharing, each
person is lifted in prayer by the other
two group members.
Help will be given for those
uncomfortable praying aloud.

Additionally, each week there will be a focus scripture and a prayer for the congregation and leaders.

The Nitty Gritty:

Enrollment is voluntary for those who want to participate. Registration forms can be found on our FUMC website, or by hardcopy in the office or on the Welcome tables. Also, look for an information sign-up table at fellowship time.

The triads will be composed of people who do not know each other well so that participants can make new friends.

IMPORTANT:

This Fall season of Triads will conclude before Advent Season.
Each consecutive gathering, people will be assigned to NEW triad groups to continue to build relationships in the congregation, building up our portion of the Body of Christ.

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What is a Triad?

Triads are groups of 3 people who meet for prayer and Christian support. Most groups are gender specific.
